APPLICATION and SELECTION

Anyone who has an interest in community affairs and is engaged in a career or other endeavor is invited to apply. **Applications for Leadership 2008 will be accepted until August 10, 2007, and will be considered on a first come, first served basis.** Leadership Billings 2008 will kick off in October, 2007. Class size is limited to 30 participants!

ATTENDANCE

LB 2008 consists of ten meetings: a kick-off retreat, seven program days, one community work-day, and a graduation luncheon.

Attendance at the kick-off retreat is mandatory.

Participants are strongly encouraged to attend all days. Please refer to the application form for detailed attendance requirements and policies.

TUITION

A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is required with your application. The deposit will be applied towards the \$875 tuition fee (\$975 fee for non-Chamber member participants). This fee covers the cost of the retreat, programming, materials, meals, snacks and group transportation.
