- Current Job Orders through Job Service: 1,215
- Estimated Job Openings: 1,500
- Job Service estimates they only have 25% of the actual openings for the area, so there are probably closer to 6,000 available jobs in the Yellowstone County area.
- Montana's Unemployment Rate for July: 5.3%, down .1% from last month.
- U.S. Unemployment Rate for July: 7.4%, down .2% from last month.
- Yellowstone County Unemployment Rate for July: 3.9%, up .2% from last month.
 - Our labor force is 84,723, which means there are 3,327 individuals unemployed in the county.
 - It is interesting that there are nearly twice as many jobs than there are unemployed individuals right now.
- A few areas Job Service is seeing significant employment demand:
 - Retail and Food Service
 - Health Care
 - Financial Services
 - Hospitality
 - Transportation
 - Specifically those with CDL
 - Engineering
 - Manufacturing
