Production of the "Official" 2010 Chamber of Commerce map will soon begin and you are invited to place a display ad on the map. In the pursuit of providing a high quality map with up-to-date information and accurate detail of the Billings area, the Billings Chamber of Commerce/CVB is pleased to inform you once again of our partnership with Spring Hill Press to produce the 2010 edition of our area street map. This map will be a 2' x 3' size in full color on 70# high gloss paper. The map itself will be produced digitally, allowing both the legibility and accuracy to meet the highest standards. 20,000 maps will be printed for free distribution.

Representatives from Spring Hill Press will be contacting members beginning on August 17th, with a delivery of the maps to the chamber office by mid December. Advertising opportunities will be made available to Chamber member businesses first. In the event that there is space available after all members have been contacted, non-members will be invited to participate. Spring Hill Press will produce all artwork for the ads at no cost to the client and will present proof copies prior to publication to ensure accuracy. Each advertiser will receive one complimentary copy of the map and the Chamber will distribute the map as requested by visitors, residents, businesses and potential new residents

They can then place the hand on the pointer on the pinpoint when name appears, then click to go to the ad page and web link. All at no extra cost!
