Project Purpose

The purpose of this project is to improve greenway access for recreational opportunities, serving as a catalyst for private redevelopment adjacent to the downtown greenway.



Public Investment:
\$5.1 Million



Phase I

Phase I of the Downtown River Greenway project included greenway reconstruction on the east bank of the Big Sioux River between 6th Street and 8th Street, as well as reconstruction on the west bank of the river from 8th Street north to the new pedestrian bridge. Improvements included river walls, improved greenway access, gathering areas, seating, a widened trail, a new pedestrian bridge, and landscape and irrigation improvements.



Public Investment:
\$4.2 Million



Phase II

Phase II of the Downtown River Greenway project includes greenway reconstruction on the east bank of the Big Sioux River between 8th Street and approximately 9th Street. Improvements include river walls, improved greenway access, seating, a widened trail, and landscaping and irrigation improvements. Phase II also incorporated a stepped river edge similar to Phase 1 and an interactive water feature.

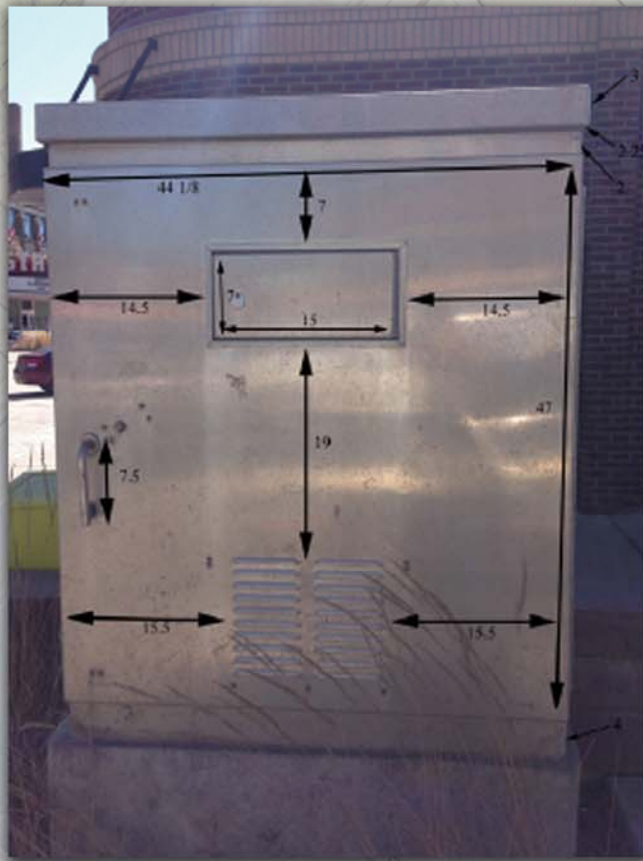

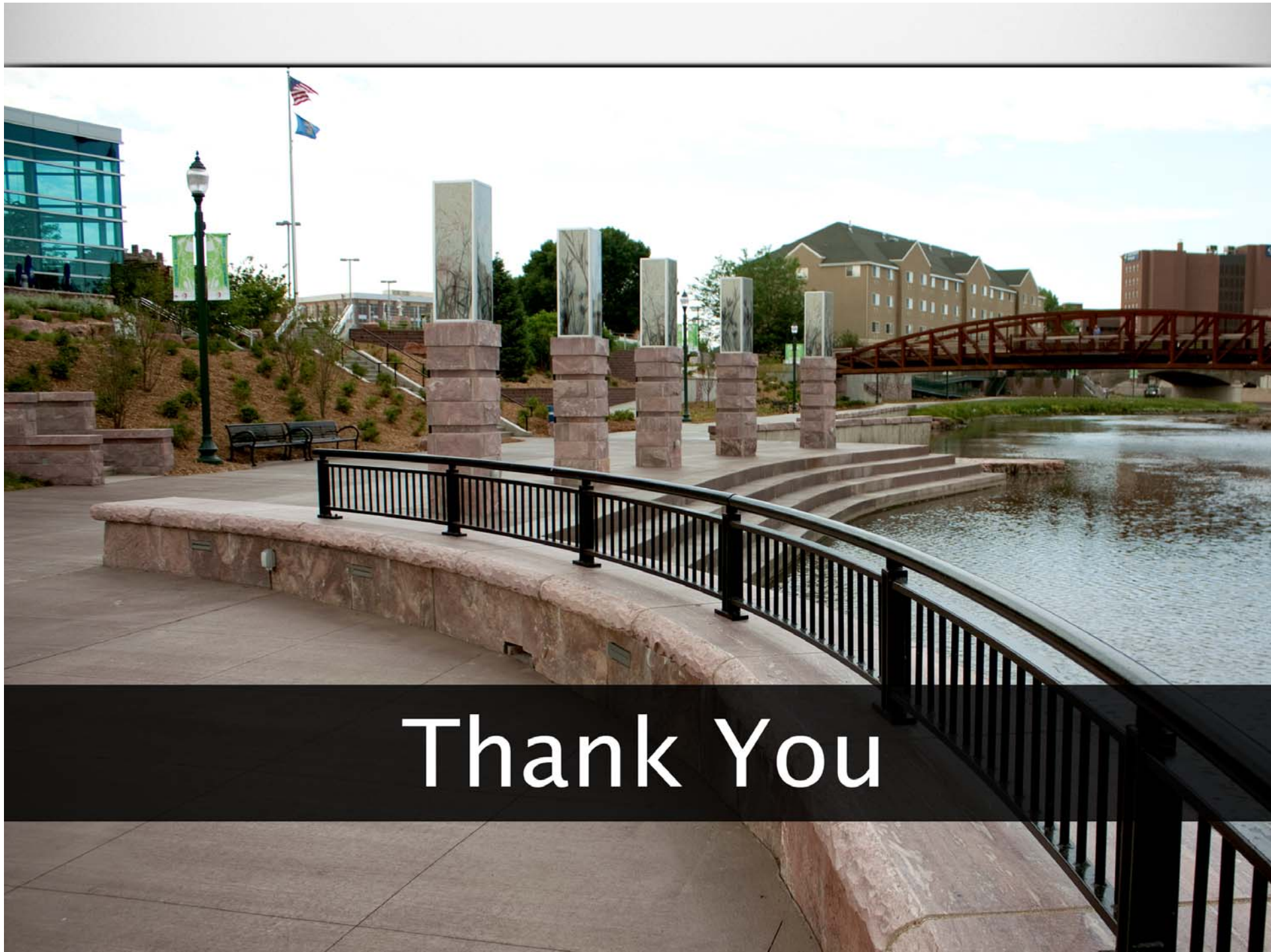
